
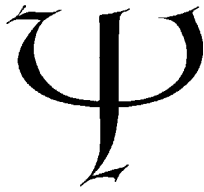




**Applying To The Group Psychotherapy Doctorate (Psy.D.) Program
Professional School of Psychology**

1. Carefully read all the details on the program's website:

3. To begin the application process:
 - Request the application form from Dr. D'Achiardi-Ressler or Dr. Canales.
 - Complete the application form **by May 31, 2016**. Since enrollment is limited and admission is on a selective basis, applications should be made as early as possible. All application materials must be received in our office by this deadline. Decisions are made only on completed applications. The PSP only admits new students for the Psy.D. in Group Psychotherapy in the summer of each year.
 - Request two recommendation letters from supervisors that know your work, and/or instructors in your graduate program.
 - Write an autobiographical statement according to the guidelines in Part 2 of the application form.
 - Send the following documents by email to Dr. D'Achiardi-Ressler and Dr. Canales: 1) the complete application form; 2) a scanned M.A. certificate; 3) scanned transcripts from all higher education institutions you have attended; 4) curriculum vitae; 5) reference letters; and, 6) autobiographical statement.
 - After they approve your eligibility for the program, please mail your M.A. certificate and original transcripts from all colleges and universities attended to the PSP. Transcripts must be official; that is, mailed directly from your college or university in a sealed envelope. Send them to:

4. Pay the application fee of \$50 (US) on the PSP website, by following these steps:

5. After the completion and review of your application, you will be notified if you are being invited to the interview process. Two online interviews will be scheduled: one with the program directors (Dr. Canales and Dr. D'Achiardi-Ressler), and one with the PSP's Academic Vice President (Dr. Weinberg).
6. If you are made an offer for admission into the program, you will receive an acceptance letter from the PSP's Provost.
7. A contract will be mailed for your review from the PSP's CFO, Dr. John Bush. Please sign two copies and mail them to:
